# Shortlist #42: Limelight



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
Boo-Hooray is proud to present our latest shortlist, gathering flyers and ephemera from Limelight, the mega club that opened in New York for an unprecedented run of two decades before the turn of the millennium.

In 1983, eyepatch-wearing nightlife wunderkind Peter Gatien brought his landmark Atlanta nightclub Limelight to New York City, transforming a formerly episcopal gothic church building into a site of nightly decadence and desecration. By 1985 the nightclub had opened locations in London and Chicago. A decade later Limelight became the definitive party spot in New York, frequently attracting celebrities such as Grace Jones, Leo DiCaprio, Dennis Hopper, Dennis Rodman, as well as malevolent "suits" such as Donald Trump. The suits and celebs partied alongside the club's infamous promoters, known as "The Club Kids," who fell from grace after Michael Alig's drug-fueled murder of party-compatriot Angel Melendez in 1997. Two years later, in the midst of Rudy Giuliani's crackdown on social life in the city, Peter Gatien served a two month prison sentence for tax evasion; soon after he was deported to his native Canada.

The bulk of this shortlist is flyers and ephemera from Limelight's first two years in New York: 1983-1985. Outside of New York, this shortlist highlights a private invite for the opening of Limelight's Chicago location, made with Interview Magazine (no. 1). Notable items also include the 1983 flyer promoting the world premiere video screening of Prince's *Purple Rain* (no. 3), a flyer promoting a 1984 Frank Zappa concert (no. 6), and a stunning fold-out flyer for the release party of "Posing Techniques for Photographers and Models", written by the mysterious Cheyenne (no. 17).

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

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



# 1. Interview Magazine and Andy Warhol Invite You to the Opening Night Celebration of Limelight Chicago



#### 2. The Heat of the Second Coming



Apfelschmitt was best known for his abstract paintings, the thick, poured surfaces of which were often marked by cracks and craters. He was active in the 1980s Downtown art scene and close to famous figures such as William Burroughs until his death from an AIDS-related illness in 1990.








### 5. Malcolm Kelso Presents Maid Day, a party




